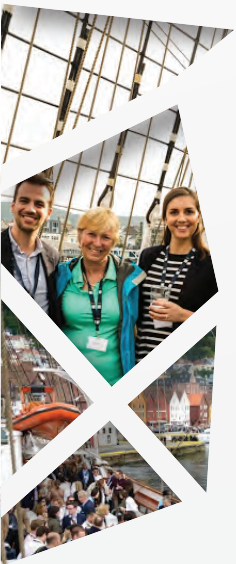


ABOUT US

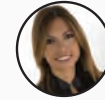


Who Are We?

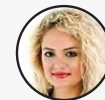

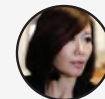
